

Tomato – Super Marmande

Semi-bush (needs some staking)

Classic beefsteak tomato, large, firm-fleshed, meaty and full flavoured. The juicy, ribbed fruit produce few seeds making it an ideal tomato for salads, sandwiches and cooking.



Tomato – Ailsa Craig

Cordon – requires some support

Prolific vines of fruit and reliability in any UK summer be it dry and sunny or damp and dull. Suitable for indoor and outdoor growing

Tomato – Golden Sunrise

Cordon – requires some support

A versatile mid-sized early variety which produces good yields of golden-yellow, medium-sized, uniform fruit. Cultivated outdoors or under glass. Distinctive sweet taste.

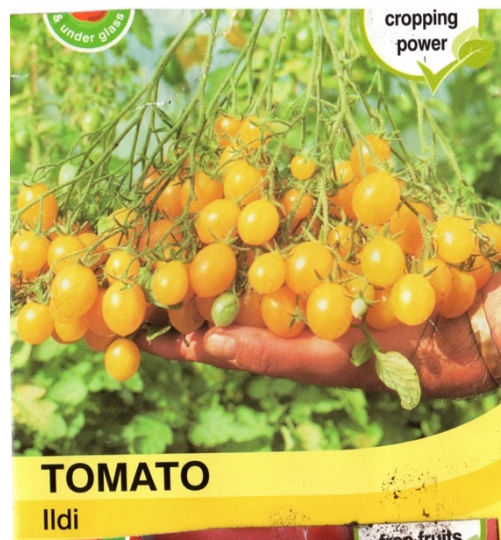


Tomato – Ildi

Cordon – requires some support

Mini, sweet, yellow, pear-shaped fruits hang like bunches of grapes, with up to an incredible 80 fruits per truss. Traditionally renowned in Italy as one of the best cooking tomatoes.

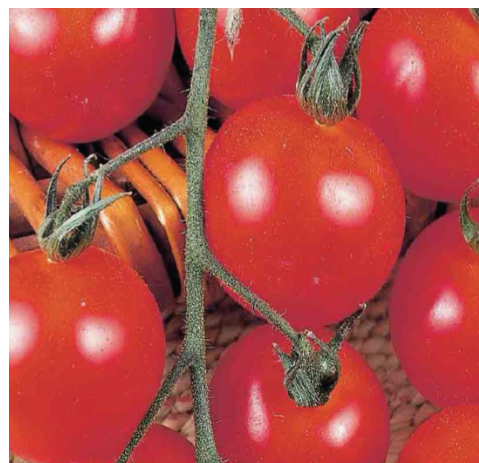
Stays compact, fruit has good standing qualities and will keep you in fruit all summer.



Tomato – Gardener's Delight

An outdoor variety with a compact habit ideal for hanging baskets and patio pots.

A popular tomato with a simply outstanding flavour which produces masses of cherry tomatoes are produced on long trusses, and you don't even need a greenhouse!



Tomato – Maskotka

A dwarf bush variety that has been specially bred for growing in baskets and containers.

Cascading stems that fall gently over the sides of their pots. produces a heavy crop of bite sized cherry tomatoes with a delicious, sweet flavour.



Courgette – Lemona

Producing high yields of bright yellow courgettes 'Lemona' is a fantastic performer.

The cylindrical fruits reach about 20cm in length and are wonderfully flavoured.

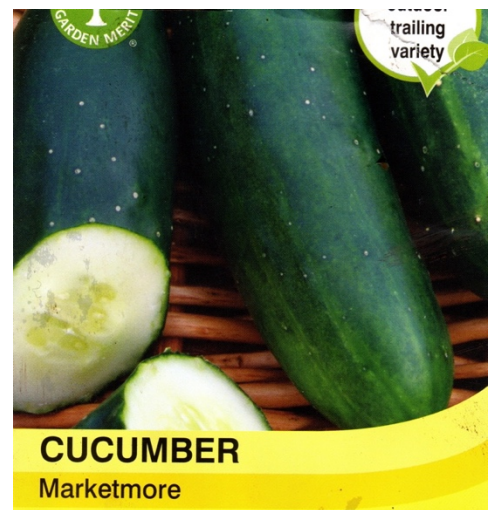


Cucumber – Marketmore

Reliable cucumber, producing large yields of 8" (20cm) long, dark skinned fruits from July – October (when harvested regularly).

Plants show some resistance to powdery and downy mildew. Do not remove male flowers.

Best grown outdoors to trail on the soil.



Chilli Pepper – Anaheim

Mild and sweet provides just that little bit of heat. Perfect for serving as a fresh garnish to spicy dishes or salads adding a chilli pepper flavour.

Produces a good crop of long green chilis over the course of the summer which can be picked and used when needed. Can also be left to ripen to a red-green colour.

Long cropping season when grown in a greenhouse, can also be grown in a sunny spot on the patio.



Chile Pepper – Padron

This Spanish Tapas Pepper are variable in heat but ideally picked small and green for the lowest levels of heat. As the chillies get larger and mature to red, the heat increases.

Excellent added to stir fries, stuffed or grilled.



Sweet Pepper – Red King

Sweet-flavoured red peppers of Sweet Pepper 'Red King' are generous in terms of fruit size, yield and flavour!

The perfect pepper for stuffing and roasting, as well as for slicing and dipping or adding to salads.

Crops throughout summer on strong, bushy plants, the peppers ripening from green to red throughout the season.



Sweetcorn – Alliance

Sturdy plants with outstanding disease resistance and hardy to seasonal temperature fluctuations.

Super sweet variety perfect for growing at home with full 20cm (8in) cobs full of juicy kernels.

Plants in grid formation around 40cm (16in) apart from each way will help your plants pollinate better. Harvest August - September, when the silks on the cob turn brown.



Dwarf French Bean – Boston

Sturdy, upright plants produce heavy crops over a long picking season.

Straight, round 15cm (6in) long pods with a dark green colour and an excellent flavour.

Plants around 15cm (6in) apart. Ideal for growing in containers. Height: 45cm (18"). Spread: 30cm (12").
